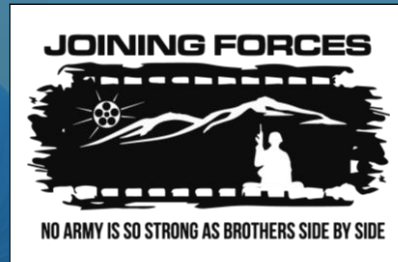




The Strongest Among Us is a book and documentary asking quiet heroes to tell their own stories of hardship, courage and survival.
